Geriatric reduce dose may be required . Famotidine (pepcid) 10-20mg Slow IVP over 2 minutes . Stable in D. 5. W, D. 10. W, NS, sodium bicarbonate 5% Fentanyl 25mcg-100mcg or 0.35-0.5mcg/kg IVP slowly over 1-2 minutes Stable in D. 5. W, & NS Flumazenil (ramazicon) Sedation initial dose: 0.2mg . max of four doses Total cumulative dose of 1mg
